



FAQ_100217: Reclassification of Finished Goods

Issue:

There is a function of "Reclassification of Material" in RM PM Store. Client wants that same function in finished product, in which only packing type is different. The product will be same with batch no. /packing type. Packing Style is also defined in MasterCard.

Example:

The bonded stock as under for the following product as on 25/11/2009. (Packing Material is same but they gave break up in batch creation as follow for the batch no. ABC001).

XYZ Cream 20gm (Export for US) (CODE: XYZ001): 20000 tubes

XYZ Cream 20gm (Export for China) (CODE: XYZ002): 15000 tubes

Now as per new requirement of party they have to send 30000 tubes of XYZ Cream 20gm (Export for US) (CODE:XYZ001). They think that in this situation the Product re-classification function will be very helpful to them but this is not available in Pharmsuite.

Solution:

They have created XYZ Cream 20gm (Export for US) (CODE: XYZ001): 20000 tubes but they want some 5000 tubes in XYZ Cream 20gm (Export for China) (CODE: XYZ002)

Sol:

Step 1: Change the quantity in TD→Excise→Bonding Slip

Step 2: Change the Batch Creation TD→PPMC→Batch Creation and edit the planned quantity as

XYZ Cream 20gm (Export for US) (CODE: XYZ001): 15000

XYZ Cream 20gm (export for China) (CODE: XYZ002): 5000

And create new Bonding Slip or edit the old Bonding slip.

Note: Entry for the new product must be passed under QA.
